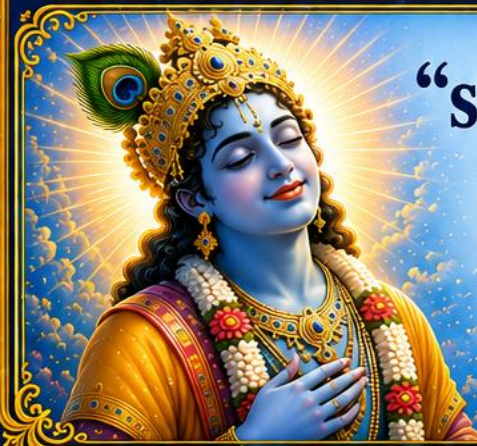

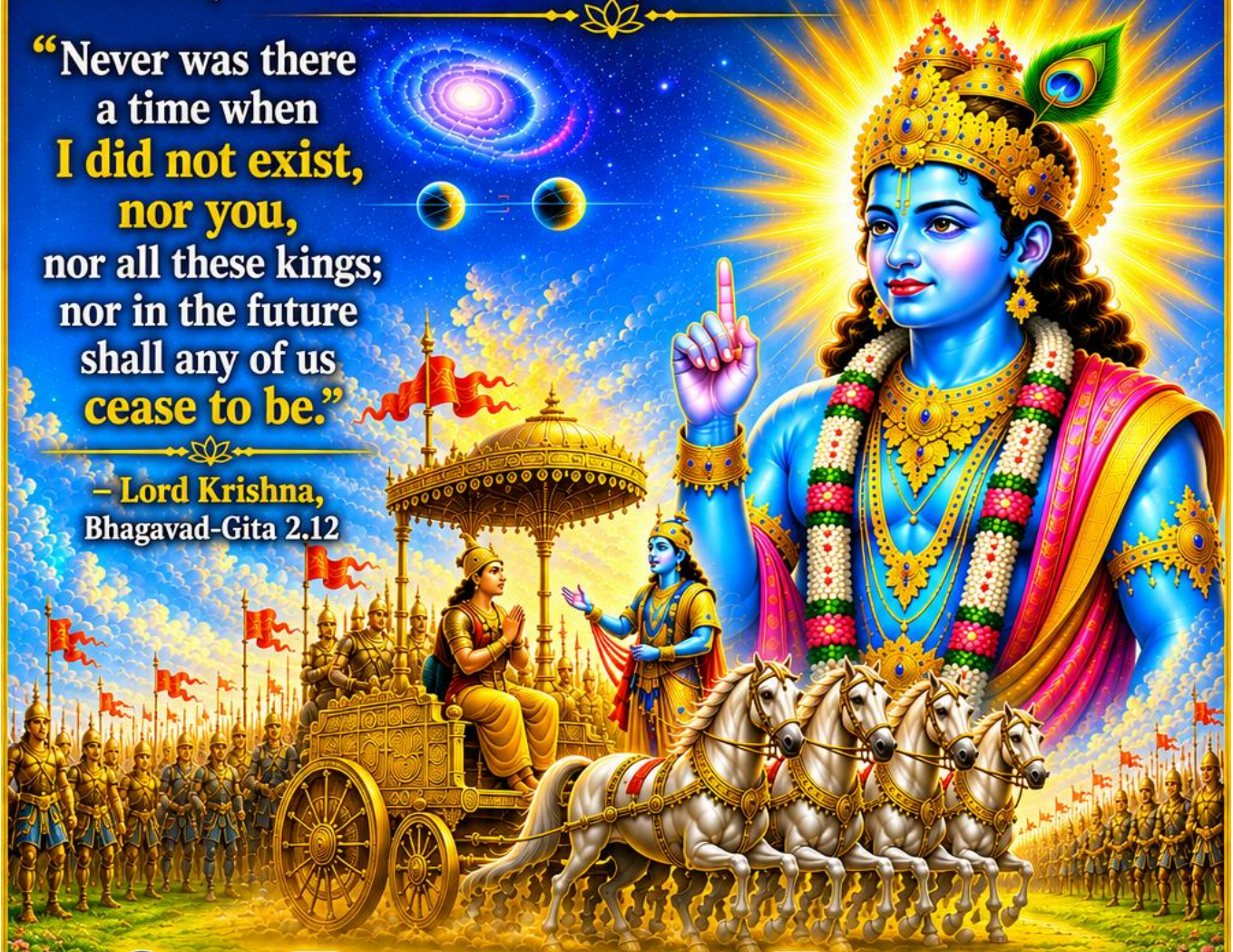

Lord Krishna Appears at Various Times

“Although I am unborn and My transcendental body never deteriorates, and although I am the Lord of all sentient beings, I still appear in every millennium in My original transcendental form.”

Millennium in the context of the above verse means one day of Brahma.

Thus, Lord Krishna appears in His original form, once in every 8.64 billion years.

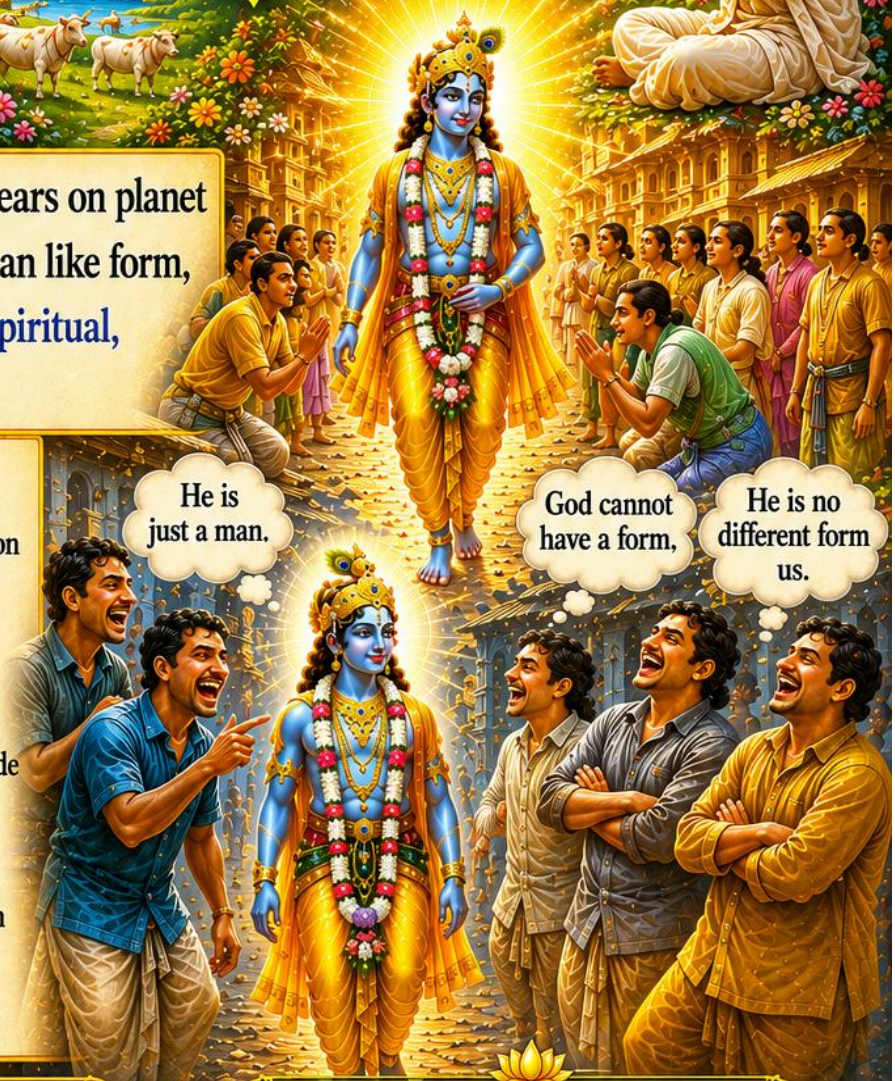


LORD KRISHNA CAN ONLY BE KNOWN BY VERY PIOUS PEOPLE.
