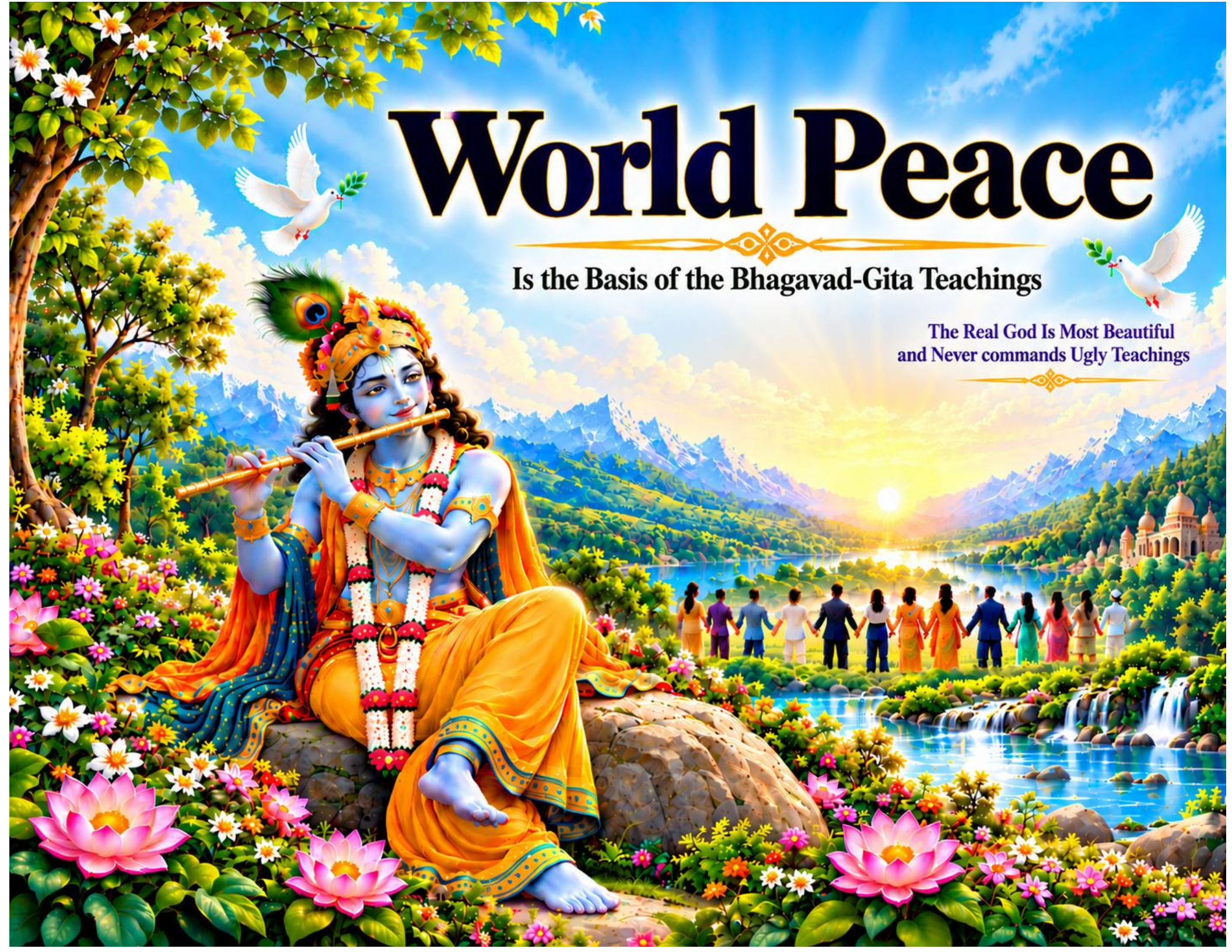

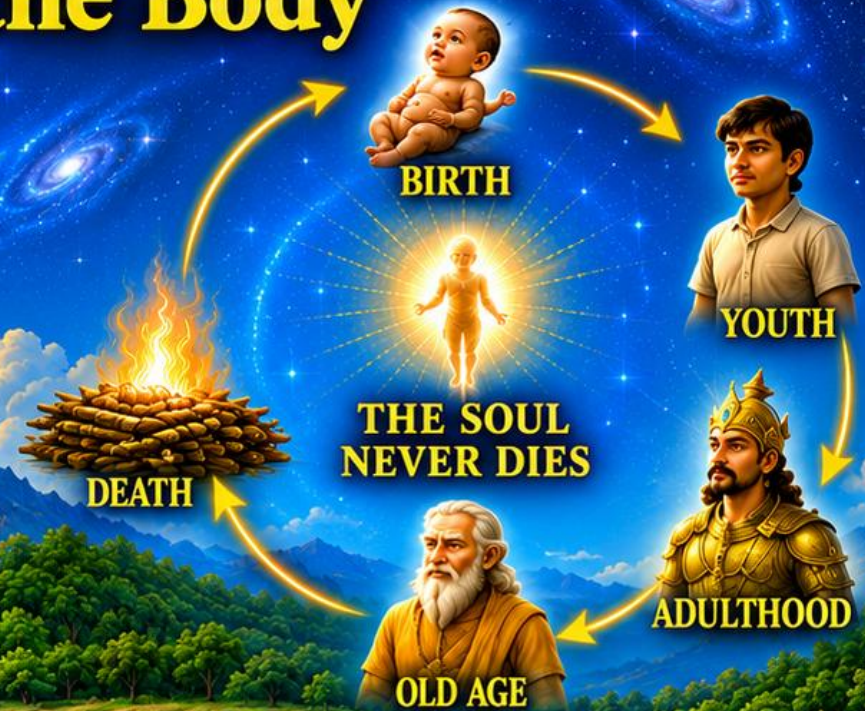
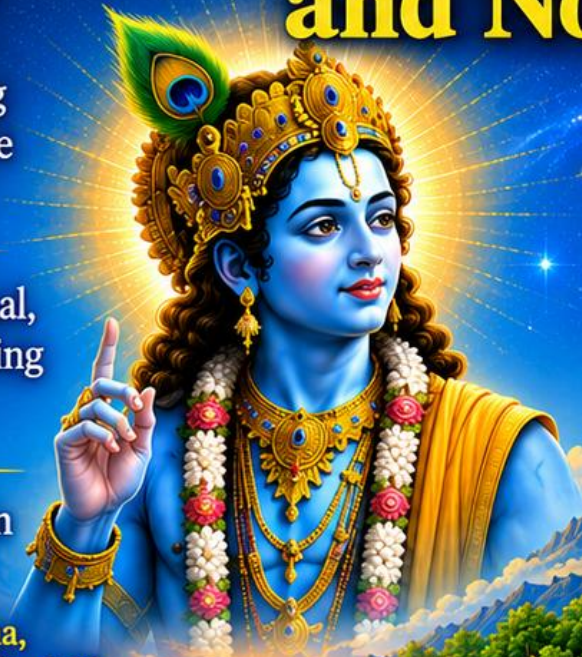

He is not slain when the body is slain.

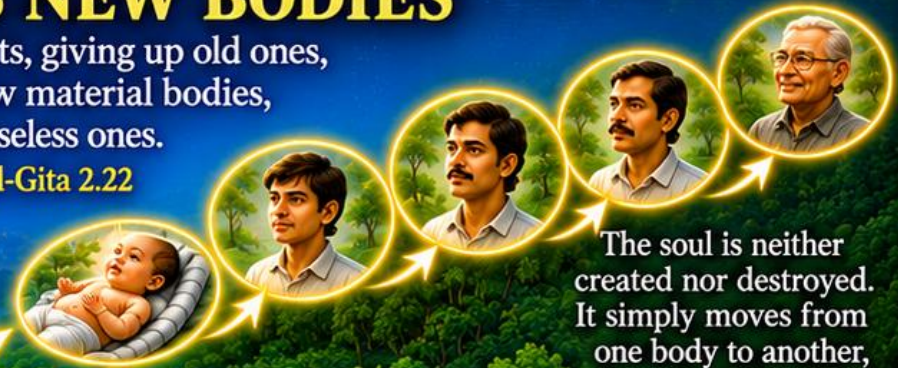

Living beings—humans, plants, and animals—have temporary, different bodies in varied conditions and places. Within each body is the living entity: the soul.

THE TRUTH ABOUT THE SOUL

- The living entity is the eternal soul, not the temporary body
- The soul is separate from the body
- The soul illuminates the body with consciousness
- All souls are equal; none is inferior or superior
- All souls share the same qualities: eternal, knowledgeable, and blissful
- The soul is situated in the heart of all living beings
- All living beings—humans, plants, and animals—have souls
- Every soul has an eternal companion relationship with God
- Every soul is a spark of God and is divine
- Every soul is accompanied by the Supersoul, God in the heart, as witness, permitter, and well-wisher
- Every soul eventually goes back to the spiritual world
- No soul is high caste, nor low caste
- No soul suffers eternally
- No soul is eternally punished or sent to hell
- No weapon can destroy, burn, blow away, or moisten the soul
- The soul is neither male nor female
- The soul is neither black nor white
- The soul is not Indian, nor American, nor African
- The soul is not Hindu, nor Christian, nor Muslim, nor atheist
- The soul is neither diseased nor healthy
- The soul is not old or young and does not age
- The soul has no weight and cannot be seen



THE FUNDAMENTAL LAW OF PHYSICS (CONSERVATION OF ENERGY)

Energy cannot be destroyed but it can change forms. We (the soul) are the energy, and the body is the form. When our current form (the body) is destroyed, we (the soul) move into another form (another body).

Total 8.4 million species of living beings.

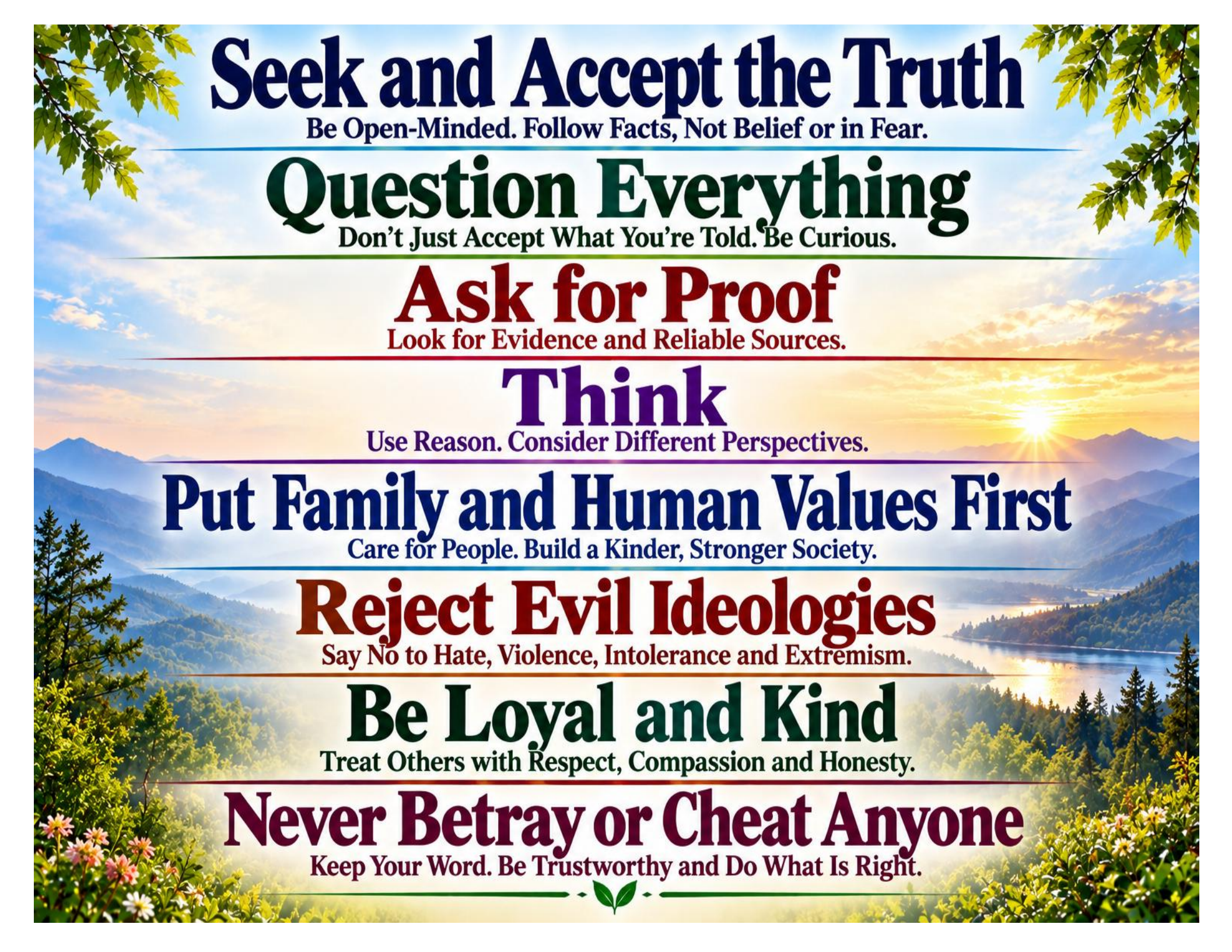
A soul occupies a particular body, exactly based on its desires, and deserves.

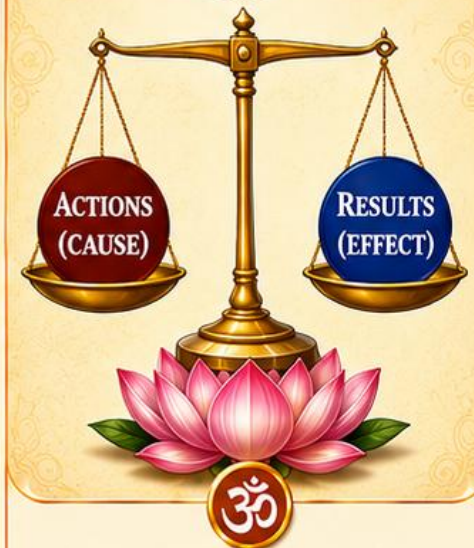
Why bad things happen to good people?

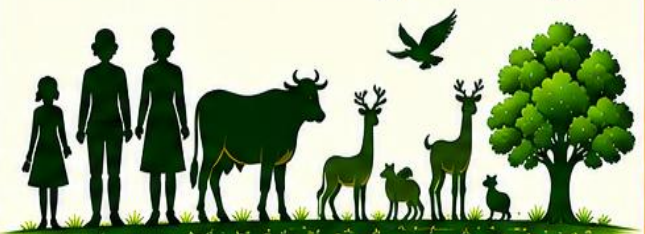

“ Fearlessness, purification of one’s existence, cultivation of spiritual knowledge, charity, self-control, performance of sacrifice, study of the Vedas, austerity and simplicity; nonviolence, truthfulness, freedom from anger; renunciation, tranquility, aversion to faultfinding, compassion and freedom from covetousness; gentleness, modesty and steady determination; vigor, forgiveness, fortitude, cleanliness, freedom from envy and the passion for honor—these transcendental qualities, O son of Bharata, belong to godly men endowed with divine nature.” (Lord Krishna, Shrimad Bhagavad-Gita 16.1-3)

How did Lord Krishna Prove He was God?

People argue over who God is. First, you must know what qualities the applicant for the supreme position should have. These qualities are listed in the question "What is God?" Then compare the pastimes, miracles performed, and statements made by the applicants for the supreme position, and then there will be no doubt who is God and who isn't.



Lord Krishna lifted a mountain (Govardhan hill) that is 21km in perimeter and weighing billions of tons for 7 days. Do you know anyone else who has lifted a mountain?



Lord Krishna defeated all those who challenged Him including Kamsa, Putana, Bakasura, Kesi, Aghasura, and Sisupala. Do you know anyone else who has defeated all those who challenged?



Lord Krishna expanded His body into 16108 forms. Do you know anyone else who can multiply himself into thousands of identical bodies or even once?



Lord Krishna saved all His followers in this life. Do you know anyone else who has saved their followers in their current life? Only a fool would accept a post-dated check.



Lord Krishna swallowed a forest fire to save His friends. Do you know anyone else who has saved his followers in their current life?



Lord Krishna transformed Himself into others. Do you know anyone else who can transform themselves into others?



Lord Krishna cured the diseased, including transforming a hunchback woman into a most beautiful woman. Do you know anyone else who has transformed the ugly into beautiful in their current life?



Lord Krishna did not come out of the womb like us. He appeared next to a woman as a baby and fully clothed.



Lord Krishna brought dead people and animals back to life. Do you know anyone else who has brought back the dead people and animals?



Lord Krishna has appeared in the same body more than 18,000 times in the current cycle alone. Do you know anyone else who has appeared with the same body these many times or even twice?



Lord Krishna showed the universe in His mouth.

The Benefits of Trees

Trees Provide Oxygen – An average size tree produces enough oxygen to keep a family of four breathing and alive.

Trees Clean the Air – Trees absorb pollutant gases (nitrogen, ammonia, sulfur dioxide etc..) and filter the air by trapping dust particles on the leaves and bark.

Trees Prevent Soil Erosion – Trees hold soil in place.

Trees Heal – By seeing trees humans can reduce stress, mental fatigue, material desires, and help humans to advance in spirituality.

Trees Provide Energy – Wood from trees is needed to build homes, furniture, and energy (fire).

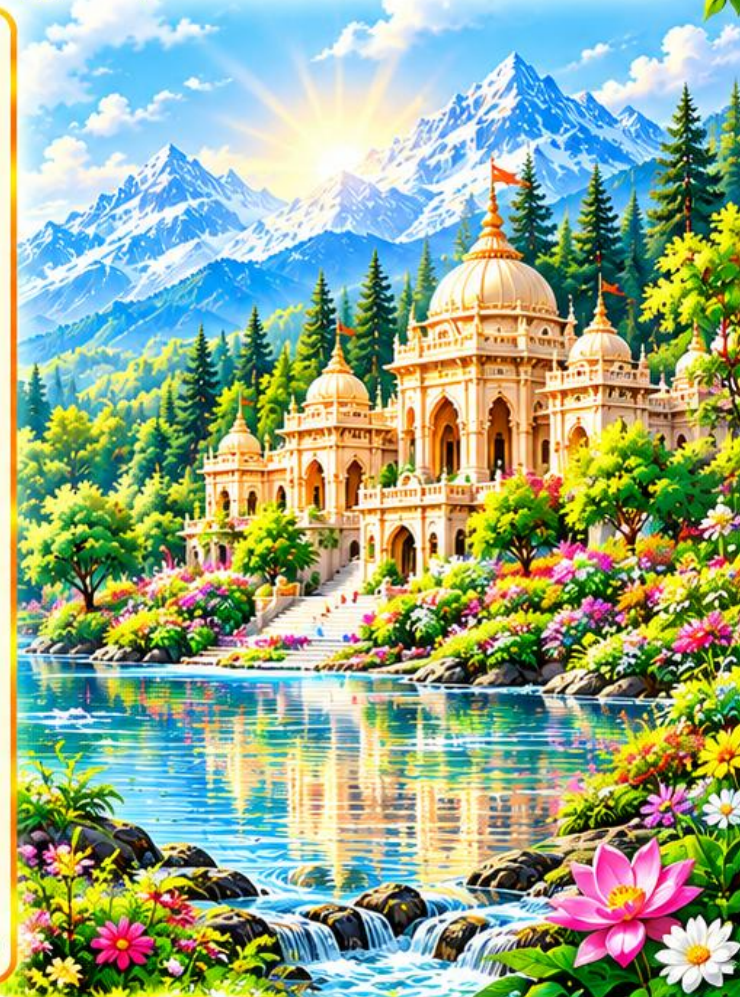
